The School of Education at American University invites applications for a term faculty appointment for Academic Year 2019-20. Rank will be dependent on experience and stature in the field. The appointment is a 9-month term faculty position and will commence on September 1, 2019. Applicants should hold a doctoral (i.e., PhD, EdD) degree in education or closely related field (e.g., child development).

This position will spend 50% of time teaching courses; serving as academic advisor for students matriculating in teaching programs; and serving on various school and University Committees; 50% of time will be spent coordinating CAEP and Assessment for the education unit.

Minimum Requirements

- Minimum 3 years of work experience designing and executing program analyses in a K12 or higher education environment, including quantitative and qualitative data analysis at various levels (e.g. student-level, course-level, program-level, and/or institution-level).
- Knowledge and experience with professional standards, particularly in Education including CAEP and Field-specific Specialty Program Associations, and analysis techniques for assessment studies, including statistical techniques, data collection instrument development (e.g., survey and interview questions), and data collection methods.
- Priority will be given to applicants who have experience in early childhood education and/or mathematics education.

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
